There is no articulation on these thirds when you practice them use different articulations to keep the exercises from being dull and to improve articulation...

There is never a reason to play fast when practicing only correctly. It takes many time of playing a passage over and over again to get out a wrong finger pattern.

Practicing slowly and correctly so you do not make mistakes will improve your playing faster then anything else you can do....

*Remember there is practicing and there is playing music and they have two completely different concepts. You practice to learn the instrument and you play to make music.
